### GENERAL INFORMATION

---

Four Way Special Utility District (Four Way SUD) is a Political Subdivision of the State of Texas. Four Way's purpose is to furnish potable water to the community. The District operates under the Rules and Regulations of the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ). The District is governed by a seven member Board of Directors that are elected by the registered voters that live within the District's Boundary. The Directors serve three-year terms. All regular monthly meetings are conducted on the third Tuesday of each month at 6:00 p.m. in the District's office located at 411 North Main Street, Huntington Texas.

The District has a staff that consists of a Manager, an Office Manager, an Office Clerk, a Field Supervisor and two Field Operators. All of the operators are licensed by the TCEQ. The District operates six water wells that can produce over 2.4 million gallons of water per day. The District operates four production plants that have a combined 440,000 gallons of ground storage capacity, three elevated storage tanks that have total capacity of 800,000 gallons, and delivers water to approximately 2,190 connections that serve a population of about 6,570 people.

#### 1. CALL BEFORE YOU DIG.

The DIG TESS Center is available 24/7. The number to call is 1-800-344-8377 or you can simply dial 811.

Texas law requires at least 2 working days' notice before beginning excavation. If you are working on Saturday, you must call no later than Wednesday.
